



# Admiral

Admiral is a concentrated moderately alkaline liquid cleaner designed for use in a variety of cleaning operations. Admiral is used for maintenance cleaning of floors, walls and heavily soiled equipment. It effectively removes grease, oils and a variety of tough soils found in steel mills and other heavy manufacturing plants. Because of its broad range of application Admiral can replace a variety of alkaline cleaners found in many plants.

- Rinses freely and completely to minimize carryover and residue
- Removes a variety of soils at economical low temperatures
- Safe on all metals including aluminum, copper and brass

## Application Procedure

Admiral is normally used between 50 and 100 % by volume depending on the cleaning requirements and equipment being used. It should be applied by non-atomizing spray or with a mop or brush and allowed to stay on the surface being cleaned for several minutes. For heavily soiled floors or equipment, scrubbing with a broom may be necessary.
